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believe? Look this way, are you sick? Yes, I see you are, say, look this way, young man. Have you been a soldier? You have, you have some kind of a jungle fever, something, some kind of a disease like that you caught overseas, is that right? Stand up on your feet and be made well in the Name of the Lord Jesus. Amen.

¹⁰⁰ Who's next there without a prayer card? What about you, lady? You haven't a prayer card? You believe with all your heart? You're anemia, aren't you? All right, go home and be well in the Name of the Lord Jesus. The man sitting next to you, there's nothing wrong with him but his eyes, stand up brother, be healed, take your glasses in the Name of Jesus Christ.

¹⁰¹ There he is, healed. What about the lady next to you, you have a prayer card? No, let's see, you believe Jesus? All right, go home and eat what you want to, you've had stomach trouble...you're healed. Stand up on your feet. Let's say 'Praise the Lord'.

¹⁰² All right, bring the patient, everyone reverent, have faith in God. Don't doubt nothing, believe the Lord Jesus, and you will be made whole. You believe this? How do you do, sir? What do you think of this feeling that's coming over you now? You believe that comes from God? You do, you should, you're a minister. Is that right? You've been out of the service for quite a while on account of arthritis. You've been praying and trying to get back, haven't you? Put your shoulder, put your cane on your shoulder and go off the platform, and preach the Gospel in the Name of the Jesus Christ. That's it, praise the Lord. He's healed.

¹⁰³ What about you, sister? With that stomach, you believe with all your heart? On a stretcher, stand up and be healed, take your stretcher away in the name of Jesus Christ. Move the stretcher. All right ministers, walk out here, let's see. Walk down through the audience, laying your hands on those people, all down through the platform. How many wants to be healed? You there with anemia, stand up, Jesus Christ makes you whole. Amen.

¹⁰⁴ Get the stretchers out. What about it, sitting there in the wheelchair? Have faith now, believe. What about the boy with the water head? Lay your hands over on it's head. Believe with all your heart. There it is. Hallelujah. Ministers, get down through the audience, turn yourself. Raise your hands. The whole... [Congregation worships-Ed.]

¹ ...Real good, to hear something like that, of all of you for the letter that our brother has read, and for the attitude of our ministering brethren here with us, and for the audience around, and your applauding makes us feel double welcome to come back again. And if the good Lord is willing, and as soon as we get the opportunity, we'll return to this city to stay longer. Until the thing is over, until God tells us it's enough time to go home at that...[Audience applauds-Ed] Thank you kindly. I trust that the meeting has been as much blessing to you as it has to us.

² I say this, where I don't have to say it, but I say it because it's the truth. I've had larger crowds, of course and bigger places, and we'd had larger crowds here if we'd had the place to take care of them, but I never met or was in a nicer meeting and meet--met nicer people anywhere in the world than I have in this place, that's right. And with the...[Audience applauds-Ed] Thank you...From my heart, and I trust that the meeting will never die, that it will live right on in each church, and among the people until Jesus comes.

³ That's our purpose of being here; to bring these meetings. And everybody's been so kind and you've been so nice, to set in this hot building, and it's very hot like this and just stand along the sides, and grouping around the doors, and come in early, and...Oh, that's so nice of you. And we appreciate it. We appreciate this brother, I can't think of his name half the time, here. Brother Banner and all the co-operating ministers, we just thank God for you brethren. And you've been so good to us, we just trust that God will just pour out His blessing everywhere upon all of you.

⁴ And to all you people there, they just tell me they taken up a love offering for me a few moments ago. I appreciate that. I don't deserve it, that's true. I don't deserve it, but Brother Baxter said all the debts were paid and everything. And then when they do that, then they get a love offering, and we appreciate it. And to the best of my knowledge and all that I know, every penny of it I shall spend for the glory of God, the best that I know how. There won't be one foolish thing that that money will go for because at that day we want to be found a good, true, faithful steward of his welfare. And some of you paid, maybe a portion of your living, I wish you wouldn't do that.

⁵ If someone would've taken up a love offering, throw in a nickel or something, and I could, you know, just something...I have to, got some children, you know how it is, but I wish I didn't have to do that, but...to take one. But I do, once in awhile because, I just...you can't make ends meet, but we thank you for it. God bless you, everyone.

⁶ Now I trust that...I remember in a meeting, I used to tell of a little story. Then...my old brother sitting here, I wanted to shake his hand before I start into the ministry or ministering of the Word. One time I

was going to take up an offering in my church. I told my wife, I said, "We just got to have one." I never took an offering myself in my life. And I said, "We got to have just a little money." I said, "I'll take up." We owed a debt, we just had to pay it, and so that was my former wife. It was...

⁷ She died years and years ago, fourteen years ago, and I was single for about five or six years. My little boy started in school. And I remarried again, God gave me back a perfect image of the little girl that he just taken from me. And, so I'm so happy about that. And then, I remember one night, it's been about eight years ago, I guess, we got to a place where we just couldn't make the things go. And I said, "I'm going over to take up an offering."

She said, "I'm going to sit down and watch you."

⁸ And so, I went over and I told old Brother Wiseheart, "Go get my hat." I was going to take up an offering. And he looked at me real strange, and he started, and I looked down and I don't know Brother Ryan if he ever knowed Sister Weber, remember her? No...Frankie's mother, and she went down under that little old checkered apron. Got out one of those old pocket book, you know, little snaps over the top, begin to pull out them nickels. Oh, I couldn't do that. I said, "I was just teasing you, I didn't mean it."

⁹ And so, Brother Wiseheart looked at me real strange, and went and hung my hat up. And you know what? Brother Ryan had rode a bicycle down to my house, and give it to me. Many of you has been in the meeting hear me refer to that. Brother Ryan rode a bicycle down there, and he just left it there and give it to me. And I painted the bicycle, and sold it and got the money to pay the debt off...?...Oh my, my poor brother. He gave me the bicycle, and really I couldn't ride the bicycle. I did owe the debt, good thing. Well, bless the Lord, that's very nice.

¹⁰ So, I thank you kindly, and it is indeed with all sincerity, my trust, that I can come back to Toledo, just as soon as possible. And when I leave Africa, come home, the Lord willing, I'm going out to seek His face to find out which move next. I believe you all appreciate that more if you know just exactly where to go. If He sends me to Toledo, we're going to stay to Toledo until He says, "You go somewhere else." And just stay there till it's over.

¹¹ Right now the meetings just in condition now to where we could really have a real revival, just right now, see? All the spooky feelings of people saying, "Well, it might be this, it might be that." But that's all gone now, just a great big welcome feeling everywhere, you see. Well, that's just the way to have a revival, that really started.

¹² Now, what do you think about four to six weeks of this would do? Oh my, we'd have a glorious time. I tell you, I believe everything in

musician. Is that right? That is right. And say, you have a...don't you have some kind of a gall bladder trouble, isn't that right? Come here, and be healed brother.

⁹⁴ Almighty God, Author of Life and Giver of every good gift, send Thy blessings upon this man who I bless in Thy Name. In the Name of Jesus Christ, come out of the man, thou demon of oppression. All right sir, my brother, go and be well in the Name of the Lord Jesus. Let's say 'Praise the Lord.' [Congregation says, 'Praise the Lord'—Ed.] Oh, what a night. Friends, God is my judge. I'm becoming so weak I can hardly stand on this platform. That's true, there is something taking place in the audience. All right, everyone just reverent as you can. Be reverent.

⁹⁵ What do you think, sister sitting down there? Do you believe with all your heart? If you do, have faith and God will let you be able to get up from there and walk. You over there, you put your arm around the lady. Don't let it shock you, but you believe also, do you? You believe she'd get well? Well, tell her to have faith. Don't weep, mother, have faith. You want to be well? You want to accept your healing? All right, you're suffering with a cancer, aren't you? Won't you stand up on your feet and be well in the Name of the Lord Jesus? Let's say 'Praise the Lord.' She come just out of her chair to accept it. Let's say 'Bless the Lord.' Praise God.

⁹⁶ How many of you people don't have prayer cards? Let's see your hands around. That row, looks like none of you have prayer cards. What about you, lady sitting there, do you believe? With all your heart? Do you believe God sent me here as His servant? You believe that I'm his prophet standing here? You accept it. All right well, if I tell you something, will you believe it? Jesus Christ just healed you of that tumor just then. Stand up on your feet, and be made well. All right, go home and pass it now, in the Name of the Lord Jesus.

⁹⁷ You sitting next to her there...You believe with all your heart? You believe, accept this as God's prophet, this? You do? You'd like to get over that hay fever, wouldn't you? Is that right? Alright, stand up, and be over it in the Name of the Lord Jesus, accept your healing. Amen.

⁹⁸ What about the lady sitting next to her, what do you think about it, sister? You believe with all your heart? Let's see if I could see you. Do you believe me as God's prophet? You do. All right, you got poor circulation, it's caused you to come to a paralyzed condition. Stand up on your feet and receive your healing in the Name of the Lord Jesus. Somebody help her there...She's up, and her arm come straight! Let's say 'Praise the Lord', that's the way its done; in the Name of the Lord Jesus. Hallelujah.

⁹⁹ That's the way, sister, you're going to be a well woman. What about the man sitting next to her? Do you have a prayer card, sir? Are you

the Gospel, isn't that right, aren't you a minister? [Brother says, "That's right."—Ed.] And you're suffering with a nervous breakdown. Isn't that right? [Brother says, "That's right."—Ed.] Well, come here and be healed, brother.

⁸⁷ Almighty God, Author of life and Giver of every good gift; Satan, this demon come roaring out there, he know that challenge of faith was on him. In the Name of Jesus Christ, come out of this man, leave him alone.

⁸⁸ God bless you, my brother. You've put a great strain on your nerves, and your age too, you see it's just the time, man goes through that the same as women. You're going to be a well man. Go off the platform, preaching the Gospel and go on, be well. Let's say 'Praise the Lord.' A minister will be well, ever who is all around Fort Wayne there, watch him, there's nothing wrong with him. Satan just grabbed him, that was all, scared.

⁸⁹ Many people just say, "Well, you get next to yourself." How can you, when something is there to scare you? And look here, reverend, you that just was healed, look here. Let you know what I'm talking about. There's at least sixty percent of these people setting right in here tonight suffering with the same thing. They're suffering with a nervous condition. How many will be honest, that you're nervous, raise your hands. How's that? About sixty percent, is that right? Allright, that shows I'm...that God reveals to me what I'm talking about, is that right?

⁹⁰ When that demon went off of you, they shook all through there like that, made me blind for a few minutes. I believe every one of you right now, while that minister's healed, that's bothered with nervousness can be healed right now. Satan knows he's lost his battle, sure he does. He knows he's a lose...My, sure, thought you were dreaming right now...people are healed. That's true. That can't last long, brethren. That's marvelous.

⁹¹ All right, bring your client, patient. That's right, just a little bit behind me if you will kind of, right along there. All right, oh my people, please believe me as His servant. Something took place right then, be reverent.

⁹² How do you do, sir? I believe this is our first meeting time in life. I don't believe I've ever seen you before. I've never seen you, is this your first time to see me? You've had photographs, I see. Yes sir, and you like to do that, do you, photographs? You do photographs. Not with camera, you don't do any photographing. You love the Lord with all your heart? I believe that.

⁹³ Say sir, you're suffering with some kind of a weakness, that you get real weak and blind, don't you? I see you some times, you just kind of go down. Is that right? Ah, no, you're not a photographer, you're a

the...around would be healed. If we could just one by one...Now the Lord has blessed us this week. The lame has walked, the cripples has been healed, and the deaf has heard, diseases, the...you know, healed and the Lord...And I want you to remember this, especially to the pastors.

¹³ There'll be weeks after this that you'll hear people in your churches say, "Well I, that stomach trouble I had left me." And I don't know, "That women..." and so forth, and the different troubles that you had, there's been at least, I would say this, not trying to say anything wrong, because I don't want to do that. God hold me responsible, but there's been at least five hundred people, I'd say, lowly estimating that's set in the audience that's never said a word about it, that's healed right now.

¹⁴ Now that's right, the other night when...the last two nights, I've never felt such a pull on me in all my life. Now the way that feels...Come here just a minute, brother. When people are being healed, now I just want to take this moment to explain this. If when I'm talking to a person, I turn and get their attention, like out in the audience. I look at somebody and see, maybe it looks kindly...Well, I go to talking to that person, and when I go to talking, then I get in contact with their spirit, and then it seems like there's something starts pulling just like this. And then when it lets up, I get real weak; that person's healed. That's all. Thank you, brother. That person is healed. They may not recognize it right then, but they will later on. They'll recognize it. They'll recognize it has been done.

¹⁵ Now, may the good Lord bless everyone of you, and just fill you with His goodness and mercy. And all of you sitting along here; here I see these three, four crippled chairs sitting here, and people with different ailments that's suffering and everything. Now, you just be of a good courage and believe with all your heart, and God's going make you every one well. I don't know if there's anyone laying back under there so far, its just right down here, sometimes I miss seeing these people, looking over the top of them, watching out there.

¹⁶ Now...Well, I don't know what else to say, but to tell you, I'm so happy to be with you, and I trust that maybe if you get a chance sometime when your own church hasn't got service, next week just slip up the area with us, we'd be happy to have you. And, write me sometime, write me down home, I'd be glad to hear from you.

¹⁷ And sometimes in sending out these anointed cloths and so forth. How many believes in sending those out those? Oh, that's wonderful. Well, I tell you, if you just go into my office and see the thousands of healings takes place just by sending those cloths, just thousands. Here recently, I sent one to Germany to a woman that had arthritis for years, and it was translated on the back of her German writing. She got a hold

of that cloth and she pinned it on her, and followed the instructions, and she said, "Now Devil, you get out." She got up and walked across the floor, she was...You see, "Now Devil, you get out." Now she just believed it and...

¹⁸ A little something, I hope if I've told this testimony just a moment before the audience, you forgive me for it, 'cause I sometimes telling around different places, I don't know if people's been in the meetings. An outstanding one was one night when I was in a little church meeting at Corning, Arkansas, just starting. And I used to take and stand, and give the people handkerchiefs, and in the meetings like here, here's a box of them. I don't get a chance to minister to those, just like this, because I'm always from the meetings going on in deep prayer.

¹⁹ Then when I go home, Brother Baxter was with me the other day, I've got a cave way back in the hills where I go to. I showed him where I met the Angel on the path, I was going back there all torn up, and I met him on the path. And He told me, said, "You return back to your car, where I called you to be with Ern Baxter." And I went to him, and we've been together. So right on that place, I go back there and pray hours after hours over every piece of goods that I send to the people.

²⁰ Now, I don't send handkerchiefs because they cost about ten cents apiece and we send out around, oh, anywhere from five, six, seven thousand a week. I don't have the money to do that, but I buy hundreds and hundreds of yards of ribbon and cut it off in little strips like this so that people can pin it on their clothes. I'd be glad to send you one. If you don't need it right now, put it in the Bible on Acts 19 and just keep it there, and if an emergency arises, take it and lay it on your child that's got the croup or whatever takes place, and believe God. Just as a little token of His love in this meeting, and many things that has been done. And it's free of charge; just send it, we'd be happy to send it to you.

²¹ Now I...This lady, I gave her a handkerchief, she wanted me to. She said "Bless the handkerchief." Now a lot of people anoint them, that's alright, anything that God blesses, I'm for it. But if you watch the Scripture, Paul didn't anoint them, he taken them off of his body, (see?) just off of his body. I believe that's right, isn't it?

²² And Paul knew that, you know where I think he got that, brethren? I think when Elijah taken the pole, and said, "Take my staff, and go lay it on the child." See? Elijah knew that everything he touched was blessed, so whether the woman would believe it or not. Then Paul taken from his body handkerchiefs and aprons, and laid it on the sick, and unclean spirits went out of them, and diseases were healed. Now, it wasn't Paul, it was God. It was God in honoring the people's faith in his servant. Well, if the same God was there, I'm not the Saint Paul, none of us are; but He is still the same Jesus, you see. It wasn't Saint Paul anyhow, but it

Jesus would come tonight, I'd be happy to step back and let you all go in. For I believe you would do it before me 'cause I'm just running over the road that you all have paved.

⁸⁰ Now, you pray for me, and as the people are here. I'm trying...It's the first time I've ever done this, about first or second time as I remember, of trying to have the spirit of discernment while there is kindly...you understand, do you brethren? It's from both sides, you see, like that. All right, now believe with all your heart there, sir.

⁸¹ All right, all right, you come, brother. Right, yes, that's alright, just so I can talk to you just a little bit and now, I suppose we...as far as I know we're strangers...?...[Brother says, "That's right, I've never...I've seen you before, at Fort Wayne, but that's all."-Ed.] Oh, you was at the Fort Wayne meeting, [Brother says, "I was at the Fort Wayne meeting, yes."-Ed.] Yes, but didn't get in the row.

⁸² I'm just going to talk to you just a little bit. Because that's just to contact you, see, your spirit. Now that was a wonderful meeting, wasn't it? [Brother replies, "Yes, it was."-Ed.] It was marvelous, that's where the only time that I know of that the...I believe that paper called, "We the People", that famous book, it's that meeting went in there that night, the little blind girl was healed at the platform.

⁸³ The Assemblies of God people, it was in your paper and so forth when a little blind girl came up. And then the papers wrote around there that she could not see after she was prayed for, and her father went down to the place and brought the child, and proved it and everything...When I took the little girl aside and that blind spirit was cast away from her. Was anybody there that night when it happened?

⁸⁴ Yeah, there is hands, there's somebody's waving back in there, that's right, everywhere. It was a marvelous time. The little girl was--had a stomach trouble, and lots wrong with her and there, how many Assembly of God people takes that, what is their paper that says this? Evangel, how many read that article in the Evangel, let's see your...The Pentecostal people takes the Pentecostal Evangel...Yes, there is several hands around, that read the article. And that was in, We the People, an international book this year.

⁸⁵ Now, on that...If you will stand right this way, sir. In that meeting, signs and wonders were done, wasn't it? [Brother says, "That's right, yes."-Ed.] I believe in that meeting, I testified about being-going overseas, and that boy being raised from the dead somewhere in there I spoke of it. [Brother says, "Yes, I remember that."-Ed.] You remember that. It was about right on a year before it happened, but it happened. And God always brings things to pass just the way He says. [Brother says, "That's right."-Ed.]

⁸⁶ Sir, while I'm standing here, I see you slip back, you're a minister of

lot of your time, but I just love you so much, I just had to have a few words to say to you before leaving, on the Gospel. It's kind of hard when you're speaking like that, and then go right back into the anointing of this other. It's a different feeling and everything, it isn't like speaking or something, but I pray that God will bless each one of you now. Give you...

⁷³ How many's going to believe with all your heart now? How many of you will just keep your hand up now, and say like this, "Brother Branham, I'm holding onto God to answer your prayer tonight?" Are you doing that? All right, you do that. That's solid, almost I'd say one hundred percent. Something's got to happen.

⁷⁴ Brother, sister, I've said this, and I'm going to say this before the anointing comes down on me deep; don't pay no attention the way I'm acting up here, cause that's just the... You're not in this world at that time. I know where I'm at, but I don't know what I'm saying or doing most of the time. Listen, the Angel of God told me, "If you get the people to believe you, and then be sincere when you pray, there's nothing will stand before your prayer."

⁷⁵ And I said, "Sir, they won't believe me, I'm uneducated."

⁷⁶ Said, "You'll be given two signs." And he told me what the signs, as you understand, he said, "When this is done, they'll believe then." And then, after those signs is done... which is infallible. Is it the truth? It is the truth, alright. Then you've accepted it, now upon that basis, anything can happen.

⁷⁷ Hear me, anything can happen; don't you pay any attention to any senses. Don't you pay attention to any doubts or any mechanical things, you listen to the Holy Spirit tonight, and if you'll do that, and do just as I tell you to do, you'll see the Glory of God. I'm saying that to you down here too. I'm saying to every one of you, believe and be in prayer, and accept Jesus Christ as your Healer. And say to God, that you're going... that you believe you're going to be healed. God's going to make you well tonight, and you shall receive what you've asked for. All right, everything ready. All right, bring them in.

⁷⁸ How do you do, sir? I just try to get that around, so that the people... that out there in the audience will be able to hear. You'll check that for me sometime, Brother Baxter. Now my brethren, I want you all back here with one accord, to believe. You don't have to keep your head down 'less I ask.

⁷⁹ But I want you to believe me, I'm here representing the same Gospel that you've preached all these years. And you brethren, some of you here is aged man to me, and you, back when I was a little boy, you were preaching this Gospel and contending for it, and now I'm just merely running the road that you've paved, that's all. If there is any credit...if

was Jesus.

²³ Now, this woman taken it and put it in her Bible, and a few weeks after that, she was cleaning a lamp chimney, way back there in the cotton country of Arkansas. And the old lamp chimney, it was broken, and cut the artery in her arm.

²⁴ Now this is her story. She got a pillowslip and put over it, and it just got wet with blood. She got a sheet... The closest neighbor was two miles, and her husband was in the city. And she was bleeding, getting weaker and she knew she was going to die shortly, if something didn't happen. And she thought of the handkerchief, she went and got the handkerchief and laid it on there. Now here's her testimony; when her husband came in that evening, she waded about two mile or better through the mud with her boots on. Hung a lantern in the tree, caught the Greyhound bus and come to Little Rock where I was holding the meeting, and walked in with these boots on holding this handkerchief, praising God.

²⁵ The handkerchief wasn't even stained, just a miracle, just stopped it right like that. The woman was dying, that's the only thing that she could get to, like that, that she knew of, and God honored her faith in doing so.

²⁶ Now we, all we-us believe that. We'll send a little thing with it that tells you how you get to your pastor and get him to come, and confess your faults, and get rid of everything, and then lay it on there. Then there is nothing in the way; God will do it. Don't you believe that? And, now God be with you.

²⁷ And thank you again. From the pastors to the co-workers, the strangers in our gates, the custodians here at the auditorium, all the ushers, you've all been wonderful, and may God's richest of blessings be upon you all. Pray for me while I'm going yonder to pray for someone else.

²⁸ I want to read just a little bit of Scripture before we start the meeting, because we want to get plenty of time in the prayer line tonight, just as long as we can. Then immediately after this, I got to catch a Greyhound bus, and bump my head till morning, I couldn't get a reservation, and I've got to go home. The wife was going to try to get here, and she couldn't get here, no one to bring her, so I have to go in tonight to get her to come back tomorrow, and be in here again.

²⁹ So, pray for me now while I read this Scripture, found in Saint John 4:46, beginning:

So Jesus came again into Cana of Galilee, where he made the water wine. And there was a certain nobleman, whose son was sick at Capernaum.

When he heard that Jesus was come out of Judæa into Galilee, he went unto him, and besought him that he would come down, and heal his son: for he was at the point of death.

Then said Jesus unto him,

³⁰ Now listen close...[Blank spot on tape—Ed.]

Except ye see signs and wonders, ye will not believe.

³¹ But listen to this gallant man answer our Master:

The nobleman saith unto him, Sir, come down ere my child die.

Jesus saith unto him, Go thy way; thy son liveth.

³² Now the man wanted Jesus to come pray for his son. But Jesus told him, He didn't go pray for him, He said,

Go thy way; thy son liveth. And the man believed the word that Jesus had spoken unto him, and he went his way.

And as he was now going down, his servants met him, and told him, saying, Thy son liveth.

Then enquired he of them the hour when he began to amend. And they said unto him, Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him.

³³ See, he was just mending, getting a little better.

So the father knew that it was at the same hour, in the which Jesus said unto him, Thy son liveth: and himself believed, and his whole house.

This is again the second miracle that Jesus did, when he was come out of Judæa into Galilee.

³⁴ Let's bow our heads. Lord, now the service is almost ready to begin again, a closing night here among this lovely people. God, how did You ever bless me in such a way, to bring me up and let me be able to stand, and talk to such an audience of people, lovely born again Christians? Oh God, I just love You for it.

³⁵ And there is no words that I can find to express my thanks, that You let me meet these ministers and these people out here. Lovely people, Your people, the very cream of the crop of the earth's harvest. And not only that...to meet them and to know them, but to have fellowship with them through Thy Son, Christ Jesus. And to know that I'm a fellow citizen with them, an heir of the same kingdom of God. We're journeying through earth, going to heaven where we'll associate together throughout ceaseless ages, through eons of time, we'll be together forever.

³⁶ Not where we'll be sick again, or not where we'll be in buildings, and have to crawl across the country to pray for each other, but where there'll be no sickness, and there'll be no old age, or there'll be no

for them man to stand anywhere." Said, "Every person that can be stood in is stood, and they'd turned away since the early in the afternoon, or the evening", and said, "There's nowhere..."

⁶⁷ And just then, the Holy Spirit revealed something to me. I said, "Leave them brothers right where they are." It's not as I don't want my brothers here, but here they're believers, you're believers, and some of them are needing healing too. That's right. And when it's coming cross-ways, this way, it mixes me up. You see what I mean? It's mixing me up. And when I'm turned sideways, I turn the patient this way, there is no need-way of turning the patient, to get out.

⁶⁸ Did you ever turn a radio on, about three or four stations trying to come in at the same time? That's the same thing when I feel the moving. Those are demon powers; not demon of your soul, demon of your body. Brother Baxter's explained all that to you. And when they come against that, I just...They fear. And if you notice, one here will be healed of something, and then a kindred spirit with sympathy out there will be scared and take out after the person. Have you seen that take place? Sure, they know when they're whipped, you can't fool them.

⁶⁹ Someone, the other night, I was at a place where they said they had a healing meeting, and some man that's standing there stomping and kicking the platform hard, said, "Devil, come out of it, devil." Now, he don't care how much you cut up. That ain't going to bother him, you can't scare him. There is only one thing that'll move him, that's true Divine faith in Christ. That'll take him right now, he's afraid of that. That's right. When you really got the blood of Christ behind you backing your faith up, moving up like that, he'll move away. He recognizes it. Alright, now everyone be reverent.

⁷⁰ Where's Billy? Alright, did you get...what prayer cards did you give? Z, how far? 51 to a 100. Let's take just about ten. Let's take 90 to a 100. Get 90 to a 100, Z90 to 100. Line up here according to your cards, right away. Now how many in here hasn't got prayer cards, let's see your hands. Oh, that's good, the front line here, that's the way. I'm glad you're here, now you sit this way. How many down in the audience down here, have you got prayer cards? Very few, just now and then. Alright now, somebody look at prayer cards and see if they got that hundred to...?...call Brother Baxter.

⁷¹ Oh, 90-90 to a 100, yes. 90 to a 100. See if someone deaf, they wouldn't be able to hear, and look at the one next to you, and see if they got their cards lined right. I'm just a little late, but I'm going to try just...you pray for me 'cause I'm just, pray for me, brethren. It's hard for me to preach and come right back out and this...[A brother begins to pray for Brother Branham—Ed.] Yes sir.

⁷² Excuse me, audience, for speaking tonight like I have. I've took up a

Move like You did last night, oh Angel of God. Come down upon this building...and I believe if You'll give us another chance after last night showing Your power. If You'll give us that chance tonight, I believe, Heavenly Father, if You'll send Him to manifest Himself again that the sick and everyone in here will receive Him with one heart and one accord, and there will be healings, Lord, that will be talked about for months and years to come. Grant it Lord. These kind blessings and favors we ask in Jesus Christ Name, Amen.

⁶¹ Thank you, sister. I know it's very hard...?...hot like this, we can't help that. I wish now, this lovely song, *Abide with Me*. The hour of my death, when life is taking me away, or might the angels of God, I hope, are packing me to Glory. I believe that's already settled. When He takes me away, I hope I hear that song being played like that, *Abide with Me*.

⁶² When the death is struggling in my throat, and the cold vapors floating against my soul. When I start down through that long valley they call the shadow of death, I want to see the Morning Star come out, light up the way for the valley of the shadow of death, and when I get to the Jordan, I expect to see two glossy wings of the Holy Ghost reach across there, bear our weary souls to a better land. Till that time, may we live faithful to Him who is faithful to His Word, in the Name of the Lord Jesus.

⁶³ All have faith in God. All believe in God, no one doubt God, but only believe.

⁶⁴ Alright, I don't know what to do. I'm asking my minister brothers just stay here where you're at. I want you to help me tonight. Will you do it? [Ministers say, "Amen."—Ed.] These men are ordained of God. They publicly come out here before the city, like this, to show their self, that they believe in Divine healing, in Jesus Christ. And they're just as much ordained to pray for the sick as anybody else there is in the world to pray for the sick. Your pastor has the same right to pray, even the lay members have a right to pray, is that right? Confess your fault one to another, and pray one for the other. Everyone has a right, that believes in Divine healing to pray for the sick. The only thing is it's just your faith to mount up.

⁶⁵ I don't know what the Holy Spirit...I've asked Him to bless us. I believe He'll do it. Are you going to believe with me now? You're going to expect Him to do it? Then everyone be reverent, and let's call a little prayer line, and get started. We'll call a few, up somewhere in the line, and then we'll, then I want some of, other people...we just don't know what the Lord's going to do for us tonight.

⁶⁶ I tell you, coming over here tonight, I just said, "Lord, I commit it to You." And when I got here, all these pastors was up on the platform. Brother Baxter said, "Brother Branham, there is not a way in the world

cripples, or no blind, but we'll be young there forever. And we'll be in His likeness, and what a glorious time that'll be.

³⁷ Oh Father, I just feel like just raising my hands up and just screaming as loud as I can to give vent to the feeling that's within me of all the appreciations of all that You've done. Bless this city, Lord; bless the people, bless the lawmakers of the city. God grant that there'll be an old fashion revival to sweep this city, Lord.

³⁸ And these anointed ones that's setting here in the Presence tonight, these ministers of God representing here on this platform, and out there, an audience. Oh God, charge their life with new vision, with new power. And may there be just be abundance of rain from everywhere, Lord, coming in to the churches. Hear the prayer of Your servant now. And now keep us ever in Your will, give us a great service tonight. For we ask it in the name of Thy Child, Jesus. Amen.

³⁹ I believe Billy has stepped out, and Brother Baxter, just a moment, just 'till they come in. Now have faith; don't doubt, believe with all your heart, and let's look tonight for the climax of all the meetings. Will you do that? I believe if God will visit us this third time, like He has the last two nights, I believe it'll settle the question, don't you?

⁴⁰ All the letters are pouring in, so I just...From places about how they're being healed and people going home, and leaving the meeting and going home, then be there maybe a few hours, then first thing you know, wake up the next morning, maybe blind, seeing. Oh, just everything's taken place. How thankful...The thing...People here, you don't get to hear it, a third of it; it's after a day or two.

⁴¹ Do you notice Jesus here? When He said, "Thy son liveth"? Well, that was one day, and the next day, he was going down, and his son had began to amend. He said this is the second miracle that Jesus did. Seemingly we wouldn't call that a miracle, but it was a miracle because anything that's out of the ordinarily, it's a miracle. Jesus told the man that his son was going to live, and the man believed what Jesus said. Is that right?

⁴² Perhaps there's a hundred prayer cards in here tonight. In a few moments, I'll call from somewhere in those prayer cards. Well, then you say, "Brother Branham, then if my prayer cards not called, what about it?" That don't mean you can't get healed. You can be healed anywhere that you'll believe that Jesus Christ healed you. See?

⁴³ Anywhere, will you always remember that? Always remember that healing, everything that Christ can do for you is already done. Amen. See? Everything that Christ and God can do for you is already done. Now, the next thing lays within you.

⁴⁴ If you're a sinner, Jesus has already saved you, but...when He died

to take away the sin of the world, but you have to accept it. If you'd say, "I'll pay your way, Brother Branham, home", it wouldn't do me no good, unless I accepted it, and Christ's death won't help you until you accept it.

⁴⁵ Now by His stripes, you are healed. He healed you when He made the atonement for you, but now it will never do you no good till you accept it, and when you accept it and believe it, then it is yours. Now, see, it's up to you. Now the things that He does, He sends signs and wonders to prove those things, that it can be done.

⁴⁶ Here, I'd like for you to write to this person or any of these testimonies I give you, you write to them if you wish. Is there anybody here from Jeffersonville? Let's see your hands, around anywhere from Jeffersonville? [Blank spot on tape—Ed.]

⁴⁷ ... "Let's pray." She never said anything about his healing, she wanted him to be saved. And so before he went, she wanted to have a witness that he was saved, and that old saint got down on the floor. I couldn't pray.

⁴⁸ Hear her pray, oh my, she opened up that heart with tears rolling down her cheeks. She said, "Lord, if you'll just let him tell me that him going to be with Jesus, that I'll be happy." And like that, and I just knelt there, and held my head down and cried like a baby. In a few moments, she raised up, she said, "Thank you, Lord," and she went over, she said, "Mommy's baby." Pat it like that, and I felt his feet, just as cold as they could be, death was on the boy.

⁴⁹ And he said, I said, does he said, "He don't know." I said, I spoke to the boy, I said, "How are you feeling now, young man?" And he just kept going, "Mmmm!" She said, "He don't know where he's at, Parson. He ain't been conscious for two days now."

⁵⁰ And I said, "Let's pray again, sister." And we knelt on the floor, and I said, "Heavenly Father, somehow or another last night a storm came up, and you grounded the plane."

⁵¹ Don't you believe that all things work together for the good? I thought, on my road home to the meetings, I said, "You grounded the plane, and this morning when the sun was shining, I know the hours is past the times now for it to leave, but somehow you led me down this way. I don't understand, but I'm putting my hands on this boy in the Name of Jesus Christ, Your Son, and asking for his life to be spared." And no more then the prayer had been made, I heard him going, "Mmmm" said, "Oh, Mama."

She raised up, said, "What does Mama's baby want?"

⁵² "Mama, it's getting light in the room. Getting light in the room."

⁵³ She begin crying. I raised up my hands, begin to offer praise. Up off

the bed come that big healthy boy, restored to his normal condition. A few months after that, I was passing through on a train. I stopped in to get something to eat; I heard somebody holler, "Parson Branham!" He was pulling one of these little old carts around like that, down there at the station, working. He run, grabbed a hold of my hand, said, "You remember me?"

I said, "No, I don't."

⁵⁴ He said, "I was the boy you come to that morning that the Lord led you down there when Mama was praying." Said, "Parson Branham, I's perfectly whole now, and I's a Christian now."

⁵⁵ ... Christian, oh brother, and you know what? That plane never left, something happened to it, it was 'bout an hour late. I got on a plane, and got home in time, anyhow.

⁵⁶ Let me tell you something. Jesus Christ the same yesterday, today, and forever. His power is only that He can't fail. He's the same God that was in Memphis, Tennessee that night; Fort Wayne, Indiana, is here tonight. Do you believe that? He's the same, He can't fail.

⁵⁷ Our Heavenly Father, we thank Thee tonight for Thy power, and how we could testify hour after hour of Your blessings, of all that You've done for us. I'm thinking of that time, down there in Memphis, and thinking over here in Fort Wayne, and the different places throughout the nation. Oh God, now You're here. It may be peculiar to some people, but Lord it's not...to we who believe You to be the same yesterday, today, and forever.

⁵⁸ We believe that You're here tonight, and You're here in Your power. And as Simeon of old was expecting the promise of the Holy Spirit to let him see the Christ before he died; oh God, the same Holy Spirit's here, and we're asking Him tonight, in the Name of the Master, Jesus Christ the Son of God to let us see His great power. Not as we need to see it, for we pray that You will do it, Lord, to strengthen the faith of others, that these next three meetings that's to be in this auditorium may be the setting forth of an old-fashioned revival that will cause churches to be filled with Your glory.

⁵⁹ And Lord, these ministers, Thy servants, setting just behind me tonight in prayer. Oh God, may each one of them be filled with the power, and may their churches be multiplied and double-times-double, Lord, of people getting saved. And may there be old-fashioned healing powers flowing to their churches; great signs and wonders, and may something happen that'll cause the city to talk for a long time. Grant it, dear God.

⁶⁰ Now, speaking tonight, this warm building, I pray that You'll hide Your servant behind the cross. And may the Angel of God come near.
